

GED Certificate & Home School Students

All students attending New Market Skills Center must be attached to a high school. With this in mind, all GED and Home Schooled students must complete the following steps to be considered for enrollment

- Prior to enrolling
 - Call the Student Services Department for the district in which you reside in to schedule a meeting.
 - Indicate to them that you currently hold a GED Certificate or have an active Intent-to-Home School document and would like to attend New Market Skills Center.
 - Download New Market's application from our website at www.newmarketskills.org and complete the student and parent section of the application. Make sure to indicate your program choice and the session you wish to enroll in.
- When you attend your scheduled meeting at the district bring the following:
 - Your New Market Application
 - Your GED Certificate or your Intent-to-Home School
- During your meeting:
 - Make sure the district completes and signs the counselor section of the New Market application
 - Make sure they indicate which High School they have attached you to, and sign under the Counselor Signature
- After your meeting
 - Return your completed application to New Market Skills Center
 - Attend a student orientation offered every Friday throughout the school year at 8:15 AM
