# Things to Know for Summer School

- **Attendance** - Students missing more than two days each session will earn a failing grade. Summer school grades will be posted on student's transcripts. The rule applies to both excused and unexcused absences.
- **Closed Campus** – New Market is a closed campus. Students may not leave during the day without parent/guardian permission.
- **New Market Deli** – Closed the first and last day of each session.
- **Lunches** – Students should bring money (cash or check), or a lunch and snacks, on a daily basis.
- **Free and Reduced Lunch Program** – Not available during summer school.
- **IEP/504** — A copy of student's IEP/504 must be turned into New Market Skills Center's office. Enrollment will not be complete until all forms have been turned in.
- **Medication** – If your student is carrying medication and/or has a Health Safety Plan, please contact New Market Skills Center's office for required paperwork. Student's enrollment will not be complete until all forms have been turned in.
- **Culinary Arts Students** – Must bring their current Food Handlers Permit on the first day of class; this permit must be valid throughout summer school.
- **Field Trips** – Additional costs may be required for field trips and supplies.
- **Electronic Devices** – Students should refer to their program syllabus for electronic device policies. New Market is not responsible for theft, loss, or misplacement of personal items.
- **Transportation** – School buses are not available for summer school. Transportation is the responsibility of the individual.
- **Program Fees** – If applicable, fees are due by Friday, June 1. Paid fees secure a student's spot in their registered program.
- **Report Cards** – Grades will be reported to sending schools to be posted on High School transcripts and Report Cards will be mailed home within two weeks after the end of each session.
- **Class Hours** – Monday-Friday, 7:30 AM to 3:00 PM.
  - Last day of each session (July 13 and August 1) release time on the last day is 3:00 PM.
  - No school on July 4 & 5.
